2	School of Public Health	Master of Public Health (Epidemiology and Disease Control)*	Bachelor's degree with a minimum of Second Class Honours (Upper Division, where applicable) in the following areas: Environmental Health, Environmental Studies, Water and Civil Engineering, Pharmacy, Nursing, Clinical Medicine, Biomedical Laboratory Technology, Biomedical Sciences, Public Health, Nutrition, Community health and other Biological sciences,.

*Please note that only these programmes/ study fields are eligible for scholarships as stated in the DAAD letter of offer.

General Requirements

1. Applicants must be from Sub-Saharan Africa.
2. English is the language of instruction.
3. They must have completed a bachelor's degree from a recognized university with above average result.
4. The last Academic degree must not be older than six (6) years.

Duration

These Master's degree scholarships are available for a maximum of TWO (2) YEARS. The scholarships will initially be granted for ONE (1) YEAR and may be extended upon individual request and receipt of a complete application made on the provided form.

Equal Opportunities

Female candidates and candidates from less privileged regions or groups as well as candidates with disabilities are especially encouraged to apply.
